

RAAF Forward Air Controllers in Vietnam

The following links feature RAAF fighter pilots serving in South Vietnam with the United States Air Force as Forward Air Controllers, some of whom are flying North American OV Bronco aircraft and others flying Cessna 02 Super Skymasters. They do not work as a complete unit but are attached to forward operational locations at six different bases scattered throughout the Corps. For the most part Australian FACs work USAF fighter aircraft, on occasions they direct strikes by RAAF Canberra bombers of No. 2 Squadron based at Phan Rang.
